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TERMS OF COMPETITION

1. The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by R&A Rules Limited and with the current Local Rules in force at the host club.
2. Competitors must be a current playing member of a golf club affiliated to Hertfordshire Golf
3. If the meeting is oversubscribed, allocations will take place, using time and date of entry received, on a first come, first served basis. Those not included will be placed on a reserve list.
4. Since payments will not be taken until the closing date, payments for withdrawals after the closing date will be reimbursed with a deduction of £5 per player, but withdrawals within 7 days of the meeting will not be refunded unless places can be filled by those withdrawing or from the reserve list.
5. The Organising Committee reserves the right to alter the number of holes played.
6. Handicaps will be verified via the World Handicap System.
7. Players may use buggies in this event if required, but the hire of them may be limited dependant on the host club and are the responsibility of the competitor to arrange with the host club and pay them directly.
8. Ties for Prizes will be decided by Committee Procedures, Competitions Rule 6 in the Official Rules of Golf (pages 402 – 404).
9. The number of strokes received by each player will be calculated as follows: Course Handicap (using the player's Handicap Index and the host course slope chart) x 85%, to give their playing handicap for the competition.
10. All disputes during the Events shall be settled by the Organising Committee whose decision shall be final. Members of that committee will be 2 from the Competition Organiser, a Hertfordshire Golf Director and the Hertfordshire Golf County Secretary
11. The event will only be cancelled on the day, if the hosting course is closed for whatever reason. In such circumstances, full refunds will be made to all players. If the course is not closed, but players decide to withdraw, no refunds will be made, in accordance with Rule 4 above
