

SEG Seniors' - 6-Man Team Qualifier – Stoneham – 15/16 July 2026



Stoneham GC near Southampton in Hampshire, was the venue for the event.

This beautiful, undulating, heathland golf course, designed by Willie Park Junior (architect of Sunningdale) was presented in immaculate condition, with fast running, browning-off fairways, and lush, heavily watered greens and striped approaches providing a rich green contrasting definition.

With a practice round on Tuesday, the format on Wednesday and Thursday, was for a team of six players, competing over 36 holes of stroke play, with their best five gross scores on each day to count.

In Round 1, with temperatures hitting 30 degrees and a stiff north easterly wind, the team produced a great effort, with all scores 76 and under, but with an incredible round from Simon Kay of 68 (-4) followed by a great round by David Lang with a 71 (-1). With a total of 365 (+5) from our best 5 scores, we stood just two shots behind Sussex.

After an evening of high excitement quickly followed by numbing disappointment watching England lose to Argentina, our aim was to improve the mood by overturning Sussex's lead to win.

In gruelling conditions again, and play at a snail's pace, it was a tough day for everyone.
